It is driven by:

- **Allianz Trade Grade:** a simple 1 to 10 scale rating indicates the likelihood of a partner defaulting within the next 12 months. A score of 1 represents a solid credit rating, and 10 indicates insolvency. A grade history can be built up from the first grade request, to follow any changes in your partners' risk standing.
- **Financial information:** access select financial data for companies in key European markets (DE, UK, IE, FR, IT, ES, BE), sourced directly from our risk database to support your decision making processes.
- **Country and sector risk:** get a 360-degree view of economic risks through country and sector risk assessments made by our world-renowned economists.
